APOGEE ADVENTURES 2024 Pacific Coast Summarized Itinerary

Trip Begins: Eugene, Oregon

Trip Ends: San Francisco, California

Mileage: 25 to 65 miles per day, averaging about 45 miles

Day 1: Our group will meet at the Eugene, Oregon, airport this afternoon. Once everyone has arrived,

we will transfer by charter bus with our bicycles and gear to the Oregon coast. This day will be spent getting to know one another, playing games, building excitement for our trip, and

learning responsible riding techniques.

Days 2-5: On the morning of Day 2, we'll start our ride south and follow the majestic Oregon shoreline

and the Adventure Cycling Association's well-loved Pacific Coast route. Our nights will be spent in Oregon State Parks, and our daily mileage will range from 25 to 50 along this scenic stretch of

coast.

Days 6 & 7: After crossing from Oregon into California, we'll ride a short distance over the border to

Crescent City. Here, we'll meet our professional surf instructors, pull on wetsuits, and spend the

morning learning how to catch waves in the warm Pacific waters.

Days 8-11: On Day 8, we'll start seeing signs for the majestic redwoods of northern California. Entering

Redwoods National Park, we'll follow the "Avenue of the Giants," a spectacular stretch of road weaving between some of the world's largest and oldest trees. Along this stretch, we'll spend a

day off the bikes volunteering with a local community group in Eureka, California.

Days 12-17: On Day 12, we'll leave the redwoods and enter California's "Lost Coast" region, a rugged, lightly

traveled area of dramatic landscapes. The road we follow, California Route 1, hugs the coastline and passes by small salt-water farms and through small towns like Mendocino, where we'll

enjoy another day off the bikes as we explore the charming coastal town.

Days 18-20: Our last day of riding will take us through beautiful Marin County to San Francisco Bay and the

Golden Gate Bridge. What a finish line! We'll beam with pride as we ride together across this world-famous bridge to San Francisco. A short distance away is our youth hostel near Fisherman's Wharf, where we'll spend the last two nights of our trip. On our last full day together, we'll take to the streets and explore this fantastic west coast city by foot. A festive

final dinner at a local restaurant will cap our three-week adventure of fun, exploration, and achievement. On our last morning, we will transfer by van to the San Francisco Airport for

pickups and to catch flights home.
