2026 New England Mountains & Coast Summarized Itinerary

Trip Begins: Wakefield, Massachusetts (flights into Boston, MA) **Trip Ends:** Wakefield, Massachusetts (flights out of Portland, ME)

Days 1-2: Our group will meet outside of Boston in Wakefield this afternoon. From there, we will load

up our van and trailer and travel to the White Mountains of New Hampshire, where we will spend our first afternoon familiarizing ourselves with our camping gear, getting to know one another, playing games, and getting excited about the adventure ahead. On Day 2, we will hit the trail running (figuratively, of course) as we set out to explore the beauty and

excitement of the White Mountains.

Day 3: A short drive from our basecamp in the Whites will bring us north to the shores of the

Androscoggin River. Here, we will meet our professional rafting guides, get oriented, and prepare for an exciting day on the water. We will paddle the fun, fast-moving Class II and III rapids of the Androscoggin, taking time to enjoy the calmer sections with a swim or a splash

along the way.

Days 4-6: For the next several days, we will hike and explore the spectacular Presidential Range of

New Hampshire's White Mountains. From our basecamps in Pinkham Notch and Crawford Notch, in the heart of the White Mountain National Forest, we will spend our days picnicking above the tree line, admiring alpine valleys, and watching for wildlife in the New England woods. Weather permitting, we may even "bag" a few of the range's famous peaks—including Mount Washington—a true high point of the trip, both literally and figuratively.

Day 7: On Day 7, we will leave behind the pine-scented forests and riverbanks of northern New

Hampshire for Maine's rocky coastline. That afternoon, we will give back to the local community through a meaningful volunteer service project with one of several partner

organizations.

Day 8: On our final full day together, we will meet our professional sea kayaking guides for a

paddling safety and skills orientation before setting out on the protected waters of Casco Bay near beautiful Orr's Island. We may even have time for one last swim before heading to Portland's Old Port for a celebratory dinner at a local restaurant—a perfect way to end a

quintessential New England adventure!

Day 9: Day 9 marks our final morning together. After packing up camp one last time, we will make

our way back toward Wakefield to say our farewells, reflecting on an unforgettable nine

days together and promising to stay in touch with new friends.
